Description of the organisation

Experience of the organization in previous European projects

In 2013-05-30 Trakai District Municipality Council decided to reorganize budgetary institution Trakai Education Centre into two institutions: Trakai Adults School and Trakai Educational Assistance Authority (orig. Trakų švietimo pagalbos tarnyba (TSPT)) - which takes over the provision of non-formal adult education, qualification raising and pedagogical psychological services.

Trakai Educational Assistance Authority is an open and modern institution, which is oriented in the needs of the region, the tendencies of education, culture politics, news society as well as the strategy of lifelong learning. The mission of the institution is to create a flexible environment for a lifelong learning, which offers a variety of possibilities for person's personal and professional development, possibilities to improve the qualifications one has as well as to develop new competencies and abilities.

There are 2 departments:

- * Non-formal education (seminars, qualification courses, conferences, Olympiads, competitions, other events) for teachers, specialist who work at schools, other educational personnel
- * Pedagogical psychological services

Institution has close collaboration with Trakai Adults School and other Trakai municipality's secondary schools, gymnasiums in activities of projects and education, organizes seminars, courses for teachers and other pedagogical workers.

Initiates and develops projects in different levels and participates in different activities, concerned with analysis, researches, education development and social conditions improvement, provides advice/psychological services especially for youngsters, young families, teenagers.

Experience and Expertise of the organization in the project's subject area:

Traku svietimo pagalbos tarnyba (en. Trakai Educational Assistance Authority) is the institution in the region providing informal education. As the main objectives of institution are: to organize the qualification improvement work of the members of educational institutions and other communities, to initiate active participation in the educational reform and to help teachers who work with pupils having special needs: to provide information, consultation and recommendations – we actively collaborate with educators, teachers from different educational institutions, involving schools.

The main spheres where we are working in are:

Therefore the project aims and planned results could improve services and could help specialists who are working with pupils, schools' personnel.

Main activities were to share the experience on active learning materials which are used by educators, to gather and describe information communication technologies (ICT) based science learning concerned with vocational learning material, to provide practical detailed examples (as educational path) of the learning material and exercises, which allow to improve critical and creative thinking skills in education, to share active learning experiences of learners and academic staff; to apply their methods in other countries institutions and to compare the learners' behavior, to share new trend active learning science materials between the participating countries.

TSPT personnel were the authors of the final product: e-book, which provided practical examples of effective use of Active Learning Applications in Science, presented Partners countries Education system, Active methods applied in schools in Science subjects, Active learning implications, findings, research in ICT based education in Science.

2012-2014 personnel from TSPT successfully coordinated LLP Grundtvig project: Exchange of approaches and strategies for development of eco-awareness (EcoTASK) which aimed to analyze and present environmental awareness-raising methods and tools, collecting and using the best international practice, also to create learning space that allows users to develop sense of saving of nature, spirit of innovative creativity, to feel like active participants which could make changes of the global environment, to learn, to share experience and take action in purpose to preserving the environment. The purpose was to share

international experience and to get good practice from country to country, to expand the public mind, to show that you can live in a modern, luxury world without making harm for the environment.
