The main objectives of the Multiplier Event were the focus group to address:

- adopt new methods and tools based on collaborative and innovative practices to strengthen science education performances at secondary school level
- address low achievement in science basic skills through the promotion of problem-based and reallife learning scenarios allowing students to acquire a basic knowledge in science, overcoming their perception of distance from everyday life which is often associated with scientific knowledge
- implement innovative approaches to science teaching and learning through an aware use of ICT with the objective to guide students in learning science through an interactive and proactive approach
- promote of a learner centred pedagogical approach to science teaching and learning by using . innovative learning by teaching experiences.

The Multiplier Event attended by 27 teachers from primary and secondary schools but also school directors and school counsellors. The most of them have a long teaching experience in the scientific field. The event also attended by some VET trainers and special and vocational schools' teachers.

The event started with a presentation of the Erasmus+ programme by Periklis Kosmidis (Coordinator of EU Projects of Epimorfotiki), who explained the Erasmus+ funding possibilities and all of its aspects.

Anastasia Traianou (project administrator) presented the "eLearning from Nature" project, the partnership, and the primary objectives of it. She also briefly presented the activities and the Intellectual Outputs of the project. Mrs Traianou introduced the "eLearning from Nature" portal (http://enature.pixel-online.org/), and its function. Mr Linardakis Ioannis (responsible for the schools' activities and programmes office in Directorate of Secondary Education of Kilkis) and Mr Pachnis Konstantinos (Teacher in 1t Lyceum of Kilkis) presented the methodology of the creation of the e-lessons. The "Teachers' Guide" presented by Nikolaos Georgiadis (project administrator). He analysed the structure of the guide, how teachers could use it to get benefit from the use of technology in the scientific subjects teaching but also how to motivate students and make them learn in a more efficient and integrated way. The last, but most important part of the event was the discussion with the teachers. The staff of Epimorfotiki that involved in the project had the opportunity to discuss with the teachers about the main topics that mentioned before (the main objectives). The conversation was very fruitful, and some significant conclusions came out.



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
